

**NASHVILLE DEVELOPMENT
REVIEW COMMISSION MEETING
TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 18, 2008**

Commission Members Present: President David Martin, Vice-President Sean Cassiday, Member Bob Bain, Member Merwin Bugher, Member June Bryan, Member Warren Cole, Member Rosemary Saurer and Member Brenda Young. **Commission Member(s) not present:** the Representative from the Brown County Economic Development Commission. Also in attendance – Chief Administrator Phyllis Carr and Historical Landmarks Foundation Representative Laura Renwick.

1) **CALL TO ORDER:** The meeting was called to order by President Martin at 6pm.

2) **ROLL CALL:** The roll was called by Chief Administrator Carr. President Martin asked that when the roll is called to please only state the Historical Landmarks Representative person that is present at the meeting.

3) **APPROVAL OF THE MINUTES**

Member Cole made a motion to approve the minutes of the October 21, 2008 meeting. Member Saurer seconded the motion. All were unanimously in favor.

4) **REPORT FROM TOWN ADMINISTRATION**

Chief Administrator Carr spoke regarding the sign application tabled from last month for Mike Sullivan of Leward Rare Books and Prints – Docket #08-41. She left a message for Mr. Sullivan on November 13, 2008 to advise him the Commission needed a better sketch of the sign, a photo of the placement of the sign and a representative needed to attend the DRC meeting. All of the information needed to be in to the Town Administrative office by 9am on November 14, 2008 and she did not hear back from Mr. Sullivan.

Member Cole advised that this application is tabled until the Commission receives sufficient information.

President Martin noted they discussed paint palettes during the earlier work session and they need a committee to work on this and asked for volunteers. Member Saurer, Member Bryan and Member Young all volunteered to be on this committee.

Historical Landmarks Foundation Representative Renwick gave handouts to the Commission members inviting them to the Historical Landmarks Foundation holiday open house in Jeffersonville on Thursday, December 11, 2008.

Member Saurer asked how they would receive the changes made to the member handbook as discussed during the work session. Historical Landmarks Foundation Representative Renwick advised she will e-mail the changes and they can be reviewed at the next meeting.
