

FOOD & BEVERAGE MEETING

MAY 13, 2008

Discussion of the Robert's property purchase. Phyllis had purchase agreement ready for the Town Council. Councilmember Bob Kirlin stated at last Town Council meeting that family was no longer accepting bids. They had 29 interested parties (including the Town of Nashville) and their attorney would be mailing information to all interested parties.

School Bus Lot – Phyllis advised the Committee a letter was submitted to Doug Cauble asking for permission to use this lot for motor coach parking. Doug will present the letter School Board.

Matt asked if it would be possible to have a motor coach loading/unloading on Van Buren Street up from his shop, Joy Bells. Phyllis advised since this was a state highway, permission would have to be sought from the State.

Pat Reilly Parking Lot – discussion again on the parking & signage issue in this area. Clothes Closet personnel parking in the RV parking & loading/unloading areas. We need to have some signs removed or moved to certain locations to help with the confusion. Need to keep RV & car parking areas open for visitors.

Washington Street Parking Lot – May apply one inch (1”) asphalt top coat next year. May want to apply some roundup throughout the lot due to the grass growing in the parking lot.

Pine Box Theatre Lot – May apply a sealer this year.

Financial Information – Phyllis provided the monthly financial information for all in attendance to review.

David Moore with Xtreme Lawn Care submitted a bid for the following work at the Washington Street Parking Lot: Trimming of hedges (2 times per year), spraying weed killer under hedges, mulch & placement of mulch under hedges. The Committee approved the bid. Phyllis to submit a purchase order for all but one (1) hedge trimming.

Misc. Items:

Gutters need to be cleaned out at all restrooms. Phyllis to write up work order to have this work done.

Keep track of vandalism costs so report can be produced for the Town Council. We are to keep track of this information for six (6) months.

Courthouse Restrooms – These restrooms are only open during the Court House hours, Mon. – Fri. (8:00 – 4:00). Would be nice to have them open longer in the evening & on the weekends. Food & Beverage has offered to help cover the cost of a new set of restrooms where the old jail currently sits and will maintain them if allowed to place restrooms there. This would allow the restrooms to stay open longer & over the weekend.
