

**FOOD & BEVERAGE MEETING**

**APRIL 10, 2007**

**7:00 p.m.**

**Phyllis handed out information to all the Committee Members.**

**Lamond called the meeting to order.**

**Items of discussion:**

- 1) Lamond advised Phyllis to proceed with bids for the mowing & trimming of the public parking lots since Community Corrections will no longer be providing that service. Phyllis to have Roger Bush draw up specifications for the project. Bids are to be mailed to the following: Chad Guffey, David Moore, Jackson Lawn Care, Wayne Flesher.**
- 2) Lamond advised Phyllis to seek bids for the new Pine Box Theatre parking lot. It was decided to go with a 2" – 3" binder this year and top coat & stripe next year. Will have the Surveyor mark the property corners. Will have to draw up specifications before bids can be mailed out.**
- 3) Question on changing the name of new parking lot to something other than Blood Alley. Most Committee Members like the name and would like to stick with it.**
- 4) Committee Members reviewed the financial information provided to them.**
- 5) Security Camera bids was discussed. Phyllis & Lamond advised the Committee, the Town Council chose to have Police put extra patrol this area to see if that helps cut down on the vandalism & eliminating kids from hanging around in the restrooms/parking lot. Committee Members suggested to keep track for six (6) months the expense of the vandalism, clean up of such incidents along with the extra patrol. Once this information is collected, the Committee would like to submit it to the Town Council for review.**

- 6) **Discussion of Cheryl Unger's contract. Lamond discussed the information he found regarding a Independent Contractor vs an Employee. Lamond & Phyllis advised the Committee and Cheryl that only a portion of the contract needed to be reworded and the rest could remain the same. Jim Roberts will be consulted regarding the change. Cheryl asked about her 3% increase. Phyllis advised she thought that was already taken place. She would give Debbie a copy of the Food & Beverage Committee minutes, where it shows approval along with a copy of the Town Council Meeting minutes. This should be sufficient for the wage increase to go through and be retroactive back to January 2007.**
- 7) **Mike questioned the amount the Food & Beverage was paying on electric. The Committee asked for Phyllis to pull the electric bills and come up with an average for each facility. Phyllis to contact Jimmy Edwards with Duke Energy, to see if we could have these facilities metered and have him produce the results of his findings.**
