

**FOOD & BEVERAGE MEETING
FEBRUARY 7, 2006
7:00 P.M.**

ATTENDANCE: Lamond Martin, Mike Goodin, Sean Cassiday, Buzz King, Roger Bush, Amanda Morphew (Phyllis out due to illness)

Meeting was called to order at 7:07 p.m. by Lamond.

Items of discussion were as follows:

Motor Cycle Parking: Lamond stated a stencil with a motorcycle decal along with wording should be sufficient in marking the spaces. Sean asked if the Police would be able to write tickets if vehicles other than motorcycles were parked there. Lamond stated he was going to speak to Jim Roberts, Town Attorney regarding the enforcement issues.

Buzz suggested taking out the "stripping" in the residential areas. Try this for one (1) year and see how it does. Several of the members voiced their opinion and feel they should be addressed to the Town Council.

Bus Parking: Lamond meeting with Jim Roberts, Town Attorney on Monday at 1:30 p.m. Roger stated there is a jurisdiction issue, right to enforcement. Lamond drawing up a formal proposal for the Brown County School (Doug Cauble) to allow the Police Department to enforce the "Bus Parking Only". Question of who was parking in this area? Stated cars were parking in the area designated for Commercial Parking Only.

Old School Way Parking Lot: Discussion of the removal of the chain & posts that separate the two (2) parking lots, Town's & Jay Carters. Committee in agreement for the removal. Feel may be able to plant some pampas grass or such in this area. Question about the enforcement with keeping the school kids from parking in this area. Some feel this is going to be an irresolvable issues.

Old Business:

Appraisals: Linda at Area Appraisal Services in at \$42,000.00 and Buddy at South Central Appraisals in at \$39,000.00. Mike stated the Committee should make a recommendation to the Town Council to purchase this property. All members were in agreement.

Topic of the old jail was brought up again
