

**FOOD & BEVERAGE MEETING  
JULY 8, 2008  
7:00 P.M.**

**ATTENDENCE: Lamond Martin, Gloria Dobbs, Matt Gray, Sean Cassidy, Diana Boose, Phyllis Carrt**

**Meeting called to order by Lamond Martin.**

**Pat Reilly Lot – Painting issues of curbing/parking blocks. Phyllis will write up a work order to have crew paint the curbing indicating “No Parking” – with yellow & “Parking” with white markings.**

**Review of minutes from the May & June 2008 meetings.**

**Signage at Pat Reilly has been taken down. Clothes Closet employees parking where they should be.**

**Phyllis advised Committee Members that no letter has been received from the Roberts’ Family. Their attorney was to send letters to all interested parties for the purchase of their property on south Jefferson.**

**Discussion of the school bus lot/motor coach parking. Continue taking pictures. Parking lot being used for other vehicles beside motor coaches.**

**Phyllis confirmed to seek bids for the top coat of the Washington Street Parking Lot & the sealer for the Pine Box Theatre Lot. Phyllis to see if it would be cheaper to do both projects at one time vs one project at a time.**

**Gloria requested a “Public Parking (FREE) sign be placed on Main & Johnson streets for the Washington Street Parking Lot. Phyllis to check if we have an extra sign in stock. Would have to have two (2) signs.**

**Diana asked about placing sidewalks on private property, such as the area by Speedway, Tilton’s parking lot & on E. Washington toward the high school. Phyllis to research issue & get back to the Committee. Phyllis advised the Committee that a work order has been wrote up for the street dept. to check all sidewalks in town & advise of the sidewalks in need of repair.**

Phyllis advised the committee of the following requests from Judi Millikan, who maintains the flower beds in Town.

1. Stepping stones for the Old School Way Restrooms to help prevent washout to the existing flower beds. The Committee agreed with the purchase.
2. Mulching the Mound Street Restrooms as needed due to wash out. Committee agreed to do on an "as needed" basis.
3. Flower replacement – The Committee voted "no" to this, due to the deer eating the existing flowers.

Phyllis advised Lamond that the Old School Restrooms have been open later due to events in Town.

Matt asked if a asphalt burm could be placed by the old jail on Old School Way to prevent the washout of the gravel drive that runs along side his property. Phyllis will ask Roger if this is possible. County still owns that area of property.

New town map was displayed from the CVB. They have asked if the advertisement was removed from the map if they could be displayed in the public facilities. Phyllis advised that this issue was brought up at another meeting & it was voted "down", due to the extra trash that would be lying & others wanting to use the restrooms for advertising. The Committee decided to display the maps in the plexi-glass boxes at area locations.

Committee asked how the food & beverage tax was disbursed and what businesses are paying the tax. Phyllis to ask Brenda Young, Clerk-Treasurer for this information.

With nothing further to discuss, the meeting was adjourned at 8:17 p.m.
