

**FOOD & BEVERAGE MEETING**

**Items of discussion:**

**Purchase Request:** Cheryl made a request to purchase wall mounted ashtrays For the Old School Way Restrooms. Apparently the containers that are currently being used get tipped over, causing a huge mess. Lamond & Sean checked the pricing for such ashtrays & the cost for one is \$54.00. Members suggested pouring concrete into existing containers, then put sand in the remainder space. This should help prevent the containers from falling over. The question was asked about placing cameras outside the restrooms to help prevent vandalism of the restrooms along with the school kids from smoking inside & outside the restrooms. One comment made, was by having the kids continue to occupy this area, they intimidate the people utilizing the parking lot. Members feel something needs to be done about this. Gloria suggested a camera system that would show the activity directly on a computer at Town Hall.

**Robert's Property:** Bob Kirlin asked the Committee to revisit the possibility of purchasing part of the Robert's property on S. Jefferson. Suggestion made of the F & B Commission to purchase half & the Salt Creek Trail Committee to purchase the other half. Members feel it would be to much money to invest in, especially since there are issues with the path going through the School's property. Commission feels this would not be a good purchase at this time.

**Pine Box Theatre Property:** Phyllis gave each member a copy of the information received from the Title Company. Discussion on how to improve this area. Lamond suggested cleaning up the pavement and have it sealed & striped. This work would have to be done in the Spring. Will need to have the property marked so the appropriate square footage can be figured for bid purposes.

**Financial Report:** Phyllis advised the Commission copies of the financial report was in their folder for their review.

**Correspondence:** Phyllis advised the Commission copies of the October minutes were in their folders for their review.

**By-laws: Phyllis mailed copies of the By-laws to each Commission Member. Commission was asked to review the By-laws. No changes were needed at this time.**
