Ed & Doug were asking for the support of the Food & Beverage Commission to place a new set of restrooms in the proposed facility & maintain them. The Master Plans were shown of the proposed site.

Antique Alley Restrooms – Lamond advised we were still waiting on the lease agreement to be signed by Andy Rogers. Once this has been done, repairs & maintenance would be completed. Lamond advised he would be painting the restrooms a “Haze Gray”.

Proposed Property Purchases – A suggestion was made for the Food & Beverage Commission check into the purchase of the Fred Chang property located on South Johnson Street, along with getting appraisals for the Robert’s property.
