SUBJECT: TREE BOARD MEETING

The Nashville Tree Board met on Thursday, January 12, at 8:30 a.m. at the Nashville Town Hall. Present were Bruce Gould, Cathy Paradise, John Davis, Phyllis Carr, and Roger Bush.

Roger asked Bruce to provide a list of potential tree planting sites on Nashville town property. Bruce will work on providing a list.

Bruce advised that two trees located in front of the bank on west Main Street will be relocated as part of the Main Street project. One tree will be moved in front of the Colonial Building on north Van Buren and the other in front of Rhonda Kays on south Van Buren.

John will work on a tree inventory and Cathy has a few other volunteers who are willing to assist.

Dan Cook is working on a landscaping plan for several predetermined areas of town.

Roger will check to see if the Tree Ordinance has been passed. The ordinance has been in the works for several years and is a requirement for the Tree City USA status.

Cathy asked if someone from the town could take over the Tree City USA annual certification process and Phyllis said she could. Cathy will provide Phyllis with the information and assistance necessary.

There was some discussion as to whether the meetings could be held at a restaurant. Phyllis is checking with the town attorney and will provide an answer before the next meeting on April 13.

The meeting was adjourned at 9:15 a.m.
