

**NASHVILLE TOWN COUNCIL MEETING
THURSDAY, JULY 7, 2011**

ATTENDANCE – Council members present – President Robert Kirlin, Vice-President Charles B. King and Councilmember Jane Gore. Council members not present – Councilmember Sean Cassidy and Councilmember Arthur Omberg. Also in attendance –Town Superintendent Roger Bush and Clerk-Treasurer Brenda Young.

REGULAR COUNCIL BUSINESS – 6:30PM

1) **CALL TO ORDER** by President Kirlin at 6:33pm.

2) **THE NASHVILLE TOWN COUNCIL MET AT MOLLY’S LANE TO DISCUSS ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT OF WALKING THOROUGHFARES AND ALLEYS**
President Kirlin explained the purpose of the meeting was to explore closing Molly’s Lane.

Business owner Ed Ryan looked at the survey pin and reported that he was told by surveyor Dave Harden that Molly’s Lane was not an alley. With that information Mr. Ryan would like this area blocked off at all times and that according to the survey he owns half of the alley.

A resident of an apartment off the alley voiced concern that closing the alley would cause her problems loading and unloading groceries and such. She also presented an Indiana Code for the Town Attorney to review.

Mr. Ryan explained that the landlords of buildings in the alley will be responsible for taking care of the alley. He commented that he does not see the Town cleaning or sweeping the alley. Loading and unloading zones were discussed.

Mr. Ryan was asked about the ABC Board’s response to their request. Mr. Ryan advised the ABC Board has approved the plans that were submitted to the Town Council.

President Kirlin commented there are still a lot of unknowns such as landscaping and this will need DRC approval. Mr. Ryan advised he does not want to spend a lot of money on a plan without an agreement from the Town Council. Discussion regarding sidewalks, asphalt and lights at night. Town Superintendent Bush will check who owns the lights in this alley.

President Kirlin advised he is still waiting on written comment from Fire Department and Ambulance Department regarding closing the alley. He noted the Council will discuss closing the alley at the next Council meeting scheduled for July 21, 2011.


3) **ANY OTHER UNFINISHED BUSINESS OR COMMENTS THAT MAY COME BEFORE THE COUNCIL**

ADJOURNMENT


The meeting was adjourned by President Kirlin at 6:57pm.


