

**NASHVILLE TOWN COUNCIL MEETING
THURSDAY, NOVEMBER 3, 2011**

ATTENDANCE – Council members present – President Robert Kirlin, Vice-President Charles B. King, Councilmember Sean Cassiday, Councilmember Jane Gore and Councilmember Arthur Omberg. Also in attendance – Town Superintendent Roger Bush, Town Attorney Jim Roberts and Clerk-Treasurer Brenda Young.

COUNCIL BUSINESS – 7:00PM

1) CALL TO ORDER by President Kirlin at 7:05pm. President Kirlin was then wished a very Happy Birthday.

2) POTENTIAL PURCHASE OF PROPERTY – 25 ARTIST DRIVE

Councilmember Sean Cassiday made a motion that we put forth an offer to purchase 25 Artist Drive on the contingency of no greater than the average of two appraisals. Vice-President King seconded the motion. President Kirlin asked if there were any questions or discussion. There being none Clerk-Treasurer Young called the roll call vote. Councilmember Gore abstained. All other Councilmembers were in favor of the motion.

3) CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PLAN

Clerk-Treasurer Young presented copies of the old Capital Improvement Plan that has expired. She then explained the necessity for adopting a new plan for the year 2012. Clerk-Treasurer Young left the meeting to get additional copies of the 1991 and 1996 Capital Improvement Plans. President Kirlin updated the Council on the status of the letter sent to Mike Thompson regarding the four corners.

There was a discussion regarding the allowed uses, expansion of Town Hall, projects, possibly hiring a Town Manager, pursuing improvement of economic development in the Town of Nashville, setting the plan coverage years to include the years of 2012 thru 2016, etc. Clerk-Treasurer Young will work on revising the document to include the items discussed by the Town Council. This plan will be on the agenda of the 11-17-11 Council meeting.

4) CLAIMS – SEWER EXPANSION PROJECT

The claims were not presented in time to be approved this evening.

Clerk-Treasurer Young announced that we did receive the \$48,000 Planning Grant without a local match and President Kirlin will need to sign the documents this evening.


She also discussed the upcoming Town Council appointments and the placement of the ad in the newspaper.

President Kirlin asked that we add the names of the volunteers of the Redevelopment Commission to the list sent to the Homeland Securities.


ADJOURNMENT

Councilmember King moved to adjourn the meeting. Councilmember Cassiday seconded the motion. The meeting was adjourned by President Kirlin at 7:45pm.




