

ORDINANCE NO 2005-11

AN ORDINANCE TO ADMEND ORDINANCE NUMBER 2004-11

WHEREAS, Indiana statue provides that the Town legislative body shall fix the salaries, benefits and compensation of its officers and employees.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Town of Nashville, Brown County, Indiana, that salaries, wages and other compensation of officials and employees for the year of 2005 shall be set forth as follows:

Administrative Assistant (2)	\$368.57 to \$462.01 weekly
Facility/Plant Supervisor	\$12.21 to \$13.70 hourly
Crew Leader (1)	\$9.90 to \$10.69 hourly
General Labors (2)	\$8.85 to \$9.43 hourly
Utility Operator (1)	\$8.85 to \$11.30 hourly
W.W.T.P. Operator	\$15.00 per hour
Water Operator	\$20.00 to \$35.00 weekly
On-Call Employee (water, sewer and street)	\$10.00 per day
Custodian	\$11.19 per hour

- c) The compensation for the remaining employees of the Office of the Town Manager is as follows:

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Facility/Plant Supervisor	\$12.21 to \$13.70 hourly

Section 6. Effective Date


This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after November 1, 2005 and shall be used in conjunction with the Town of Nashville's general personnel policies.






