


TOWN COUNCIL AND SAFETY BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 2005-04


WHEREAS, a review of the rules and regulations of the Nashville Police Department and the standard operating procedures of said department reveals that said rules do not provide guidance to the officers of the department regarding the repair of damaged or malfunctioning weapons. It is hereby resolved that said rules and regulations be amended as follows:

1. Rule No. 88: Repair of weapons owned by the Nashville Police Department. Any weapon owned by the Nashville Police Department, assigned to a Nashville police officer or Nashville reserve officer, that becomes damaged or malfunctions shall be brought to the attention of the Marshall or Chief Deputy Marshall immediately upon discovery by the police officer or reserve officer of the damage or malfunction. The Marshall or Chief Deputy Marshall shall determine if repairs are needed and, if repairs are needed, the Marshall or Chief Deputy Marshall shall take the weapon to a licensed gunsmith for repair.






