

**RESOLUTION NO. 2008-10**


**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING TEMPORARY TRANSFERS  
TO DEPLETED FUNDS EXTENSION OF REPAYMENT**

**WHEREAS**, Resolutions 2008-05 and 2008-09 have granted temporary transfers to a depleted fund in need of funds for cash flow purposes from another fund of the political subdivision ;

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** BY THE NASHVILLE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF NASHVILLE, BROWN COUNTY, INDIANA, THAT AN EMERGENCY EXISTS DUE TO THE DELAYS IN REASSESSMENT. THE TEMPORARY TRANSFERS ARE TO BE REPAYED NOT MORE THAN SIX (6) MONTHS BEYOND THE BUDGET YEAR IN WHICH THE TRANSFERS OCCUR.

This resolution shall be in full force and effect upon its adoption and passage.






