2) TOWN MARSHAL SELECTION PROCESS


Items discussed during the committee meeting:

- The Committee agreed to recommend to the Town Council to extend an offer of a contract to Interim Town Marshal Stephanie Loerzel with a recommendation that a contract of two years followed by a yearly renewal.
- The Committee agreed to suspend this Committee unless the Town Council asks them to meet again.


ADJOURNMENT
