

**NASHVILLE TOWN COUNCIL MEETING
THURSDAY, SEPTEMBER 9, 2010**

ATTENDANCE – Council members present – Vice-President Robert Kirlin, Councilmember Sean Cassidy, Councilmember Charles B. King and Councilmember Arthur Omberg. Council member not present – President Roger Kelso. Also in attendance – Town Superintendent Roger Bush, Chief Administrator Phyllis Carr, Town Attorney James Roberts and Clerk-Treasurer Brenda Young.

AGENDA

1) CALL TO ORDER by Vice-President Kirlin at 7:00pm.

2) ROLL CALL by Clerk-Treasurer Young.

Vice-President Kirlin stated one motion the Council will make is that Vice-President Kirlin will approach ARa and call DLZ for some informational purposes. Councilmember King so moved. Councilmember Cassidy seconded the motion. All were unanimously in favor.

Vice-President Kirlin stated the other motion the Council would like to make is to instruct the Town Attorney to work out a settlement with SMI. Councilmember Cassidy so moved. Councilmember Omberg seconded the motion. All were unanimously in favor.

3) BID AWARD – 2010 STREET RESURFACING PROJECT

Vice-President Kirlin reported Town Superintendent Bush has presented his recommendations as to the bid award. Vice-President Kirlin read the recommendations to do the micro resurfacing at five locations for \$17,745.96 and to do the ultra thin overlay in two locations in the amount of \$10,625.00. Discussion.

Councilmember King made a motion to approve the resurfacing program for 2010 which Town Superintendent Bush has presented to Town Council. Councilmember Cassidy seconded the motion. All were unanimously in favor.

4) ANY OTHER BUSINESS THAT MAY COME BEFORE THE COUNCIL

Town Attorney Roberts asked the Council to consider setting up a standard procedure for dealing with unemployment applications so he does not have to wait for instructions from the Council. Vice-President Kirlin asked Town Attorney Roberts to come up with the procedures and present them at the next Council meeting.

Vice-President Kirlin asked where they were at with the new street signs. Town Superintendent Bush reported that beyond choosing the locations for the signs he has not gotten any further with this task. He can have the signs ordered next week. Vice-President Kirlin noted some of the existing sign poles need to be treated.


Vice-President Kirlin asked where they are at with the sidewalk problems out at Willow Manor. Town Superintendent Bush advised he did not receive a call back from the person on this project. Vice-President Kirlin explained the Town had asked for pavers to be put in this area and now the Willow Manor people are saying they cannot put the pavers in because there is no sidewalk or cement slab on one side. Discussion. Clerk-Treasurer Young reported this issue is going before the DRC later this month and should also go before the Main Street Committee.

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
ADJOURNMENT


