**WORK SESSION**


1) **CALL TO ORDER** by President Kelso at 6:40pm.


2) **2008 BUDGETS**

After the round table discussion President Kelso adjourned the work session at 8:45pm. There will be another budget work session on August 20, 2007 at 6:30pm.


