**ATTENDANCE** – Council members present – Vice-President Robert Kirlin, Councilmember Dale Cassiday, Councilmember Charles B. King and Councilmember Arthur Omberg. **REGULAR COUNCIL BUSINESS**

Clerk-Treasurer Young advised the Council was presented a new contract today at 2pm. Her office took the contract to Town Attorney Roberts office this afternoon and they have not heard back from him regarding the contract. Vice-President Kirlin suggested they table the contract until the Town Council meeting on January 15, 2009. Councilmember Cassiday made a motion to table the fire contract until the next Council meeting. Councilmember Omberg seconded the motion. Jessica Bussert with the Nashville Fire Department explained that the last time she brought the contract to the Council they had comments regarding paragraphs number three and number nine. She explained the contract is the same as last year's contract with the exception of the dates being changed. All were unanimously in favor of the motion.



The meeting was adjourned by Vice-President Kirlin at 4:08pm.




