

**NASHVILLE TOWN COUNCIL/
SAFETY BOARD MEETING
THURSDAY, MARCH 19, 2009**

ATTENDANCE – Council members present – President Roger Kelso, Vice-President Robert Kirlin, Councilmember Charles B. King and Councilmember Arthur Omberg. Council member not present – Councilmember Dale Cassiday. Also in attendance – Chief Deputy Marshal Stephanie Loerzel, Town Attorney James Roberts and Clerk-Treasurer Brenda Young.

COUNCIL BUSINESS

1) CALL TO ORDER by President Kelso at 6:16pm

2) PERSONNEL

President Kelso announced to the Council that they have received a resignation letter from Town Marshal Dorsett to be relieved from his duties as Town Marshal.

Councilmember Omberg made a motion to accept the resignation of Town Marshal Dorsett as Town Marshal and him being placed as a patrolman. Vice-President Kirlin seconded the motion. All were unanimously in favor.


President Kelso noted that since there is currently a change in personnel he asked if there were any initial motions regarding the position of Town Marshal. Councilmember Omberg made a motion to assign Chief Deputy Marshal Loerzel as Interim Town Marshal on her acceptance until the Safety Board meets to start a process of selection. Vice-President Kirlin seconded the motion. All were unanimously in favor.

President Kelso asked Chief Deputy Marshal Loerzel if she was willing to accept the Interim Town Marshal position. Chief Deputy Marshal Loerzel agreed to accept the Interim Town Marshal position. She then asked if it would be possible to move someone up into the Chief Deputy position. President Kelso commented that these types of details need to be worked out with the Town Attorney and referred her to meet with the Town Attorney regarding following the policies.

Vice-President Kirlin noted they did receive Interim Town Marshal Loerzel's letter concerning the grants and thanked her for the information. President Kelso advised they will address the grant information at the regular Council meeting later in the evening. President Kelso also asked that Interim Town Marshal Loerzel be present at all the Council meetings.


ADJOURNMENT


