SUBJECT: TREE BOARD MEETING

The Nashville Tree Board was scheduled to meet on Thursday, July 10, at 8:30 a.m. at the Nashville Town Hall. In attendance were Bruce Gould, Phyllis Carr, and Jim Eagleman.

Phyllis Carr advised that the Nashville budget was still, for all intents, frozen. It is assumed that the purchase of new trees and payment for removal of trees is a budget item that can be postponed until the town budget improves. The town has been presented with a list of trees that need to be removed, so that is pending and no other lists will be prepared until the first list is acted on unless an emergency removal becomes necessary.

John Davis was not present to report on the progress of the tree inventory.

The only tree issue referred to the tree board since the last meeting was for removal of a dead tree on north Jefferson Street along the Hotel Nashville property. Bruce Gould visited the site and filed a report to the town indicating that the tree was dead and had been dead for some time but was most likely located on Hotel Nashville property and that ownership should be determined before the town undertook removal.
