President Voland moved to spend up to \$400 from the 2500 fund for Ad in Our Brown County for the Art Walk. Member Hopkins 2<sup>nd</sup>, all unanimously in favor.

President Voland moved to spend \$100 from the 2500 fund to for an Arts Road 46 ad in the Art Walk brochure. Member Phil McKown 2<sup>nd</sup>, all unanimously in favor.

Potential ask from Playhouse, we should know more at next meeting. Discussion.
