

**NASHVILLE TOWN PARK COMMISSION
THURSDAY, JUNE 15, 2023**

Commission Members present: President Alisha Gredy, Vice-President Mark Shields, Member Cliff Cressey and Member Anna Hofstetter. Members not in attendance: Member Torrie Birkemeier. Also in attendance: Administration Manager Phyllis Carr.

COMMISSION BUSINESS

1) CALL TO ORDER

Meeting called to order at 3:30 pm.

2) ROLL CALL

President Gredy did roll call.

3) APPROVAL OF THE 5-18-2023 MEETING MINUTES

Member Hofstetter made a motion to approve the 5-18-2023 meeting minutes as presented. Vice-President Shields seconded the motion. All were unanimously in favor.

4) UPDATE ON PARK SIGNAGE

Administration Manager Carr advised that Chris Shuster is requesting to meet on Friday, June 16, 2023 at 1pm to confirm placement of the proposed Lincoln Pinch sign. The Commission agreed to meet with him.

5) UPDATE ON FUND RAISING IDEAS

President Gredy asked the Members if they had any other ideas for fund raising? If going with the brick idea, where would the bricks go? Administration Manager Carr suggested if the new sign had to be raised due to flooding issues, then make a brick wall around the sign using the bricks purchased to form a memory wall. If there are remaining purchased bricks, we would need to think where or what these bricks could be used for. Possibly a memory walkway?

Discussion of laser vs engraving? Cost to charge for the bricks? Members will continue to think of other options for the bricks.

6) ANY OTHER BUSINESS

Member Hofstetter advised the Pollinator event is scheduled for July 22, 2023 at the Brown County 4H fairgrounds. Discussion of placement for a pollinator garden. SW corner of the Village Green (Methodist Church side) was suggested. Town Manager Jones stated due to the number of events that are held in that area, it wouldn't be a good place for a garden of any type. The NE corner (Candy Emporium side) was suggested, but again, events are held in that area too. Administration Manager Carr suggested using the existing flowerbeds at Lincoln Pinch Park and see how the gardens do and how well they are maintained. If the beds do well, then look for another location in Town. Vice-President Shields mentioned maintenance will need to be done on a regular basis. Member Hofstetter said she would talk with Member Birkemeier for her suggestions.

President Gredy moved to adjourn the Meeting. Vice-President Shields second the motion. Motion carried. The meeting was adjourned at 4:18 p.m.
