

**NASHVILLE TOWN PARK COMMISSION
THURSDAY, AUGUST 17, 2023**

Commission Members present: President Alisha Gredy, Vice-President Mark Shields and Member Cliff Cressey. Members not in attendance: Member Anna Hofstetter and Member Torrie Birkemeier. Also in attendance: Administration Manager Phyllis Carr.

COMMISSION BUSINESS

1) CALL TO ORDER

President Gredy called the meeting to order at 3:30pm.

2) ROLL CALL

President Gredy did roll call.

3) APPROVAL OF THE 7-20-2023 MEETING MINUTES

Vice-President Shields made a motion to approve the 7-20-2023 meeting minutes as presented. Member Cressey seconded the motion. All were unanimously in favor.

4) UPDATE ON PARK SIGNAGE

Discussion of what should be placed around the new sign. Possibly put down a liner to prevent weeds from growing up through the mulch. Vice-President Shields feels the liner would end up tearing or rotting and would need to be replaced. Administration Manager Carr suggested putting the red tiles purchased from the fund raiser on the back of the sign, so it doesn't look bare. Possibly some artwork on the back. Administration Manager Carr suggested asked Chris Shuster his opinion on the sign since he designed and installed it.

5) DISCUSS BROWN COUNTY STONE FLOWER BEDS/GARDENS

Vice-President Shields is to meet with Jamie Sichting, Street Superintendent, and a representative from Cummins on August 23, 2023, to assess the work that needs to be done to the existing flowerbeds in Lincoln Pinch Park. Other volunteers from Cummins will help remove the flowerbeds on August 25, 2023, from 1-4pm.

6) UPDATE ON FUND RAISING IDEAS

Commission is still brainstorming this project.

7) ANY OTHER BUSINESS

Vice-President Shields looked at the remaining wood play structure at the Village Green. The remaining logs are rotted and have bolts sticking out. Vice-President Shields made a motion to remove the structure. Member Cressey seconded the motion. All were unanimously in favor.

Vice-President Shields provided suggestions for a play structure to go in the area of where the stepping stumps were. He will check on the cost of the play structures.

President Gredy moved to adjourn the meeting. Vice-President Shields second the motion. Motion carried. President Gredy adjourned the meeting at 4:26 p.m.
