

**NASHVILLE TOWN PARK COMMISSION MEETING
THURSDAY, JANUARY 17, 2019**

Commission members present: Member Alexis Peirce Caudell, Member Anna Hofstetter and Member Mark Shields. Commission members not present: Member Alisha Gredy and Member Melanie Voland. Also in attendance: Town Council Member Nancy Crocker, Dena and Rick Patrick, Cliff, and Administration Manager Phyllis Carr.

COMMISSION BUSINESS

1. CALL TO ORDER

Member Hofstetter called the meeting to order at 3:46 p.m.

2. ROLL CALL

The roll was called by Member Hofstetter.

3. ELECTION OF OFFICERS

Since all Commission members were not present, Member Hofstetter made a motion to not have the election of officers at this meeting. Member Shields seconded the motion. All were unanimously in favor.

4. DISCUSS FUTURE USE OF WASHINGTON/JOHNSON STREET PARK

The Town Park Commission discussed collaborating with the Tree Board Commission for Arbor Day on April 26, 2019. Within that, we discussed the yellowwood in the northwest corner that died and that there are six trees left to plant including a hackberry tree that needs to be replaced.

The Commission discussed ideas for the green-space at Washington/Johnson Street Park. Ideas included: playground, picnic area, splash pad, seasonal ice skating, dog park, green-space with added benches, sculpture park, and ADA accessible pathways. Whatever becomes of the green-space, on-going maintenance is a major concern.

Administration Manager Carr advised that the Commission needs to involve other Town Commissions such as Parking and Public Facilities and Tree Board in creating the park space.

Councilmember Crocker suggested using the Village Green Project to get direction for the Washington/Johnson Street Park. The "redevelopment perimeter" was mentioned.

5. ANY OTHER BUSINESS THAT MAY COME BEFORE THE COMMISSION

The Commission decided to request an open Community Forum from the Town Council, which was set for 5pm, on February 7, 2019.

ADJOURNMENT

Member Shields moved to adjourn the meeting. Member Hofstetter seconded the motion. Member Hofstetter adjourned the meeting at 5:02 p.m.
