TOWN COUNCIL REGULAR MEETING

WEDNESDAY, MARCH 27, 2024, AT 1:00 PM

ATTENDANCE - Council members present in person - President Andi Wilson, Vice-President David Rudd, Councilmember Lance Miller, and Councilmember Rex Watters III. Also, in attendance - Town Manager Sandie Jones, Town Attorney Wanda Jones, Police Chief Heather Burris, Chief Administrative Officer Phyllis Carr, and Deputy Clerk-Treasurer Debbie Ferry.

1. **CALL TO ORDER** – The meeting was called to order by President Wilson at 1:06pm.
2. **ROLL CALL** – By Deputy-Clerk Treasurer Ferry
3. **CONSIDER RECOMMENDATIONS OF SERVICE BID AGREEMENTS** – CAO Carr recommended the following service bid agreements:
Tree Maintenance – Vertical Landscaping (1) and John Robertson (2)
Plumbing – Voils Plumbing
Pest Control – Burt’s Pest Control
Vice-President Rudd motioned to approve the recommendations. Councilmember Watters seconded. All were unanimously in favor of the motion.
4. **CONSIDER DONATION BOX RESOLUTION** – Town Manager Jones spoke about the discussion from last month regarding the placement of donation boxes by the town parking lots and the Village Green. She noted that Clerk-Treasurer Young had some concerns about the internal controls as she had spoken with the State Board of Accounts. Town Manager Jones had contacted the Rotary Club of Brown County, and they are interested and would disburse the funds to Brown County entities. Councilmember Miller motioned to adopt Resolution 2024-04. Vice-President Rudd seconded. All were unanimously in favor of the motion.
5. **DISCUSS THE APPOINTMENT PROCESS TO THE NASHVILLE TOWN COUNCIL** – The Council discussed the appointment process, application deadlines, where to submit the applications (Office of the Clerk-Treasurer or by email) and the appointment voting process. Vice-President Rudd motioned to do the straight vote, have an open public meeting for the interviews on April 10th with the application deadline on April 5th at the end of business which is 4:00pm. Councilmember Watters seconded. All were unanimously in favor of the motion.

6. **ANY OTHER BUSINESS TO COME BEFORE THE COUNCIL** – There was none.
7. **ADJOURN** – Vice-President Rudd motioned to adjourn the meeting. Councilmember Miller seconded the motion. All were unanimously in favor of the motion. The meeting was adjourned at 1:18pm.
