TOWN COUNCIL REGULAR MEETING

WEDNESDAY, APRIL 10, 2024, AT 6:00 PM

**IN PERSON AT NASHVILLE TOWN HALL
200 COMMERCIAL STREET
AND VIDEO CONFERENCE VIA ZOOM**

ATTENDANCE - Council members present in person - President Andi Wilson, Vice-President David Rudd, Councilmember Lance Miller, and Councilmember Rex Watters III. (After the Town Council Appointment and swearing in, Councilmember Scott Dick was also in attendance.) Also, in attendance - Town Manager Sandie Jones, Town Attorney Wanda Jones, and Clerk-Treasurer Brenda Young.

1. **CALL TO ORDER** – The meeting was called to order by President Wilson at 6:00pm.
2. **ROLL CALL** – By C/T Young
3. **APPOINTMENT OF TOWN COUNCIL MEMBER** – President Wilson advised that we have three applicants to speak with this evening. The Town Councilmembers asked questions of each of the respective applicants. Bruce Gould was the first applicant to be interviewed and he was followed by James Cramer and then Scott Dick.

Vice-President Rudd asked the applicants about their vision of the town in 5 and 10 years. Councilmember Miller asked about controversies over the past few years regarding the Police Department and the noise ordinance. Councilmember Watters asked how would the Police Department combining with the Sheriff's Department logistically work out? President Wilson asked why each applicant wants to be on the Town Council.

After the Town Councilmembers questions were addressed, Councilmember Watters motioned that Scott Dick be the new Town Council member. President Wilson seconded. President Wilson and Councilmember Watters were in favor of the motion. Vice-President Rudd and Councilmember Miller were opposed.

Applicant James Cramer explained that he is inclusive and not divisive and withdrew his application of interest and asked that they vote for Scott.

Vice-President Rudd motioned to appoint Scott. Councilmember Watters seconded. All were unanimously in favor of the motion.

4. **ANY OTHER BUSINESS TO COME BEFORE THE COUNCIL** – (This item was originally slated as agenda item #5) Councilmember Watters motioned to move agenda item #5 up to #4. President Wilson seconded. All were unanimously in favor of the motion. Newly appointed Councilmember Dick recommended that James Cramer be appointed to the USB Board. President Wilson appointed James Cramer to the USB.


Clerk-Treasurer Young advised that she had prepared oaths for each respective applicant to be prepared. She then swore in Councilmember Scott Dick. Councilmember Dick then took his seat at the Council table at 6:35pm.

Town Manager Jones explained that on Facebook she saw that Earth Day will be celebrated at the YMCA from 11am to 1pm. The flyer shows that there will be Food Trucks. She spoke with them, and they said there are a couple of Food Trucks interested and the other vendors that will be present are giving away items. Vice-President Rudd motioned to let them have it and to waive the DRC for this event only. Councilmember Dick seconded. All were unanimously in favor of the motion.

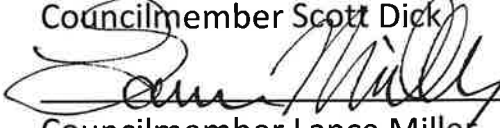

Vice-President Rudd motioned that Food Trucks have to go before the DRC before they come to the Council. Councilmember Miller seconded. All were unanimously in favor of the motion. Discussion regarding the Food Truck approval process. The Food Truck Ordinance will be on the agenda of the next Town Council meeting.


5. **CONSIDER RESOLUTION 2024-05 A RESOLUTION REGARDING THE USE OF UTILITY VEHICLES AND OVERNIGHT WORK FOR THE SANITARY SEWER REHABILITATION & WWTP IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT** – Vice-President Rudd explained what the Contractor is asking for approval. Discussion. Vice-President Rudd motioned to adopt Resolution 2024-05. Councilmember Watters seconded. All were unanimously in favor of the motion.
6. **ADJOURN** – Councilmember Watters motioned to adjourn. Councilmember Miller seconded. All were unanimously in favor of the motion. The meeting adjourned at 7:07pm.
