A. CBDG Public Facilities Program Grant

On or about December 17, 2021, the Town of Nashville, Indiana intends to apply to the Indiana Office of Community and Rural Affairs for a grant from the State Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program. This program is funded by Title I of the Federal Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, as amended. These funds are to be used for a community development project that will include the following activities: Public facilities improvements for Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) compliance for locations within the Town of Nashville, Indiana. The total amount of CDBG funds requested is \$199,260. The amount of CDBG funds proposed to be used for activities that will benefit low and moderate-income persons is \$111,585. The applicant also proposes to expend an estimated \$55,940 (21.9%) in non-CDBG funds on the project. These non-CDBG funds will be derived from the following sources: Nashville's General Fund.

The Town of Nashville will hold a public hearing on Wednesday, October 13, 2021 at 11:00 AM to provide interested parties an opportunity to express their views on the proposed federally funded CDBG project. Interested citizens are invited to provide comments regarding this project either at the public hearing or by prior written statement. Written comments should be submitted to Tara Hagan, ARa, 748 Franklin St., Columbus, IN 47201, no later than Thursday, October 7, 2021 in order to ensure placement of such comments in the official record of the public hearing proceedings. This project will result in no displacement of any persons or businesses.
