FOR THE TOWN OF NASHVILLE, INDIANA**






WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of Nashville, Indiana hereby accepts with gratitude the restricted donations from citizens wishing to donate funds to establish and maintain a Public Safety Fund for the Town of Nashville; and

WHEREAS; expenses from this fund may be used for any public safety needs; and


WHEREAS; the fund balance is nonreverting at year end and the fund will remain in place until terminated by the Nashville Town Council. If the fund is terminated by the Nashville Town Council all remaining fund balances will be transferred to the Town of Nashville General Fund.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT UNANIMOUSLY ORDAINED by the Council of the Town of Nashville that a Public Safety Fund be established for restricted donations for the purchase of public safety needs for the Town of Nashville.
