Alternate #1 Bid = \$32,994.15


Alternate #2 Bid = \$35,068.35


Alternate #3 Bid = \$19,700.00

CAO Carr asked the Council to take a look at the awning request from Carmel Corn Cottage.


Councilmember Rudd motioned to adjourn the meeting. Councilmember Hofstetter seconded. The meeting was adjourned at 2:40 pm.


