- 1. AWARD 2023 ALLEY PAVING CONTRACT The meeting was called to order by Vice-President Miller at 2:30 pm. Chief Administrative Officer Carr advised that when she read the bids aloud on April 28, 2023, she did not read aloud the last line that of reduction of the total bid if awarded all 3 alternates. She then read aloud the following reductions listed:
  - A. Wallace Construction, Inc. = \$0.00
  - **B.** J.L. Harden Paving Inc. = \$4,500
  - C. Milestone Contractors, L.P. = \$3,500
  - D. Robertson Paving, Inc. = \$26,130

CAO Carr recommended awarding the 2023 Alley Paving Project to Robertson Paving, Inc. Councilmember Rudd motioned to award the bid to Robertson Paving, Inc in the amount of \$61,632.50. Councilmember Wilson seconded. All were unanimously in favor of the motion.

CAO Carr asked if the Council had a chance to look at the site of the proposed awning at the Carmel Corn Cottage. Discussion regarding setting a precedence and possibly impeding the sidewalk.

Town Manager Jones advised that Bob Willsey has resigned from the Redevelopment Commission and asked for the Town Council to come up with an appointment.

Councilmember Hofstetter spoke about the grant feasibility study for the bike and walking paths. She will contact the Brown County Commissioners regarding their partnership in this study.
