- 1. 2022 BUDGET WORK SESSION** – was opened by President Gore at 4:00pm. She then turned the work session over to Clerk-Treasurer Young to explain the budget process and procedures. Clerk-Treasurer Young reviewed the budget calendar for the tax budgets. She advised that the budget calendar is not for the Water and Wastewater Utilities. There were questions asked regarding possible raises for employees, percentage of the Police Department's budget in the General Fund, and the hiring of Taft for lobbying for the Nashville Food & Beverage Tax renewal. The Work Session was opened for public comments and questions. There was support regarding the need for our Police Force and budgeting sufficiently for their department. The next budget Work Session was scheduled for August 25, 2021, at 6:30 pm.
