AMENDMENT TO RESOLUTION NO. 2021-01

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF NASHVILLE, INDIANA, ESTABLISHING A CITIZENS ADVISORY COMMITTEE TO PROVIDE RECOMMENDATIONS AS TO A HUMAN RIGHTS COMMISSION

WHEREAS, On the 21st day of January, 2021 the Town of Nashville Town Council adopted **RESOLUTION 2021-01**, for the express purpose of establishing a temporary citizens' advisory committee for the purposes set out in the title of said resolution.

WHEREAS, At the February 18th 2021 meeting of the Town Council, the members of the Committee were nominated and appointed by the Council and,

WHEREAS, After discussion at the February 18th 2021 meeting the Town Council considered that the three (3) month term for the members of the Committee was not sufficient to accomplish the stated purposes of **RESOLUTION 2021-01** and that as much as nine (9) months might be required. On motion properly made and seconded the Council voted unanimously to amend said resolution to extend the term of the members of the Committee to nine (9) months.

THEREFORE, It is hereby resolved by the Town Council of the Town of Nashville, Indiana that **RESOLUTION 2021-01** be and is **AMENDED** as follows;

Section 1, sentence 3 shall read:

3. Members are appointed for a term of nine (9) months.

In all other regards, **RESOLUTION 2021-01** shall remain unchanged.
