PROCLAMATION ALZHEIMER'S AWARENESS MONTH

WHEREAS, Alzheimer's disease is the nation's 6th leading cause of death, affecting more than 5.8 million Americans and 110 thousand Hoosiers living with the disease; and

WHEREAS, more than 340 thousand family members and friends in Indiana provide 387 million hours of unpaid care for a loved one with Alzheimer's; and

WHEREAS, the physical and emotional impact of dementia caregiving is estimated to have resulted in 290 billion in health care costs for Alzheimer's and dementia caregivers in 2019; and

WHEREAS, the total Indiana Medicaid costs in 2019 for Americans with dementia age 65 and older is 981 million; and

WHEREAS, early diagnosis of Alzheimer's could save as much as 7.9 trillion in health and long-term care expenditures; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Nashville recognizes the efforts of the Alzheimer's Association to highlight early detection and diagnosis of the Alzheimer's disease and other dementias, education, support and research, thereby improving the financial, physical, and emotional health for those living with Alzheimer's disease and their caregivers;

THEREFORE, the Town Council of Nashville, Indiana claim June 2019 as Alzheimer's Awareness Month in Nashville, Indiana.
