COMMISSION BUSINESS

1. CALL TO ORDER

Meeting called to order at 10:03am by Vice-President Stephens. Discussion of temporary structures and food trucks.

Discussion of approval for events at the Brown County 4-H Fairgrounds. Member Gould feels that the Fair Board should be the entity responsible for approving what events happen there, including food trucks. Even though it is annexed into Town limits, the Fair Board should be the responsible party.

Member Gould will write up a guideline to be reviewed at the next work session. If approved by the DRC they will send to the Town Attorney for approval.

Member Benson requested that any food truck should provide their own trash cans.


Discussion of where food trucks could be placed. Only on private property, such as parking lots (IGA, Bear Hardware, Andy Tilton's parking lot).

Discussion of creating a food truck zone map indicating where food trucks were allowed. Also discussed sound/noise, lighting, seating and number of food trucks allowed for the season.


