

**PROCLAMATION**  
**MAY 6, 2018 ACCESS BROWN COUNTY DAY**  
**NASHVILLE, INDIANA**

**WHEREAS**, Access Brown County started in 2004 with "The Community Wide Needs Assessment", which identified and verified the need for door to door transportation in Brown County. A Brown County Transit Committee was established in 2006 to secure funds for this start-up and in 2009 the Van began to roll; and,

**WHEREAS**, usage over the past four years has increased from 2,892 to 10,770 annual riders and all senior citizens ride free, which last year totaled 4,203 riders; and,

**WHEREAS**, funding for this program has always been difficult and presently Access Brown County is funded with money from the County, donations, Thrive Alliance, passenger fares and a match from INDOT; and,

**WHEREAS**, on May 6, 2018, Access Brown County hopes to raise over \$10,000 toward the INDOT match grant which means with this match it would be \$20,000 and will help to sustain this important service to our community.

**THEREFORE**, we the Access Brown County Board along with the Town Council of Nashville, Indiana proclaim Access Brown County Day in Nashville, Indiana as May 6, 2018.


