ORDINANCE NUMBER 10-05-09-01

ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AND APPROVING AN INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT FOR ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT WITH THE TOWN OF NASHVILLE

WHEREAS, Ind. Code § 36-1-7 authorizes political subdivisions to enter into interlocal cooperative agreements for the joint exercise of powers.

WHEREAS, Brown County, Indiana, has by ordinance established. the Brown County Economic Development Commission and designated the office of the Auditor of Brown County as the proper depository of funds to be applied to the operation of said Commission.

WHEREAS, Brown County, Indiana, has public funds eligible for use by its Economic Development Commission and regularly exercises its power to give such moneys to the fiscal agent of the Commission.

WHEREAS, the Town of Nashville, Indiana, has public funds eligible for use by its Economic Development Commission and regularly exercises its power to give such moneys to the fiscal agent of the Commission.

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Brown County, Indiana, is the legislative body of the County, the Brown County Council is the fiscal body of the County, and the Nashville Town Council is the legislative and fiscal body of the Town.

WHEREAS, the County and the Town of Nashville wish to enter into an interlocal agreement to provide for the County to act as the fiscal agent for the Brown County Economic Development Commission, to provide for payment of Town funds earmarked for economic development to the county for partial payment of expenses of the Brown County Economic Development Commission for the year 2009.

BE IT THEREFORE ORDAINED as follows:

- 1. Entry into an interlocal agreement for the payment of \$5,000.00 from the Town of Nashville to Brown County, Indiana, for partial payment of expenses of the Brown County Economic Development Commission for the year 2009, is hereby authorized and approved.
- 2. Said funds shall be used to partially defer the expenses of the Brown County Economic Development Commission for the year 2009.

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- 3. Payment of said funds shall be made by the Town to the Auditor of Brown County, who shall permit said funds to be used by the Economic Development Commission only for the purpose set forth in the interlocal agreement.
 - 4. In the event that Brown County does not use all of said payment, any remaining

unused portion of it shall be refunded to the Town of Nashville no later than 30 days after the close of the County's fiscal year for the year of 2009.

- 5. A copy of the interlocal agreement is attached hereto, and it and this ordinance shall become effective upon passage and compliance with all procedures required by law.
- 6. This ordinance and the accompanying agreement shall be filed with the Brown County Recorder upon their full execution and shall be filed with the Indiana State Board of Accounts within 60 days of their full execution.

BROWN COUNTY, INDIANA, AND TOWN OF NASHVILLE, INDIANA INTER-LOCAL FUNDING AGREEMENT: ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT

WHEREAS, the present and future prosperity of the Town of Nashville is directly linked in a great extent to the economic development of Brown County, Indiana.

WHEREAS, the Town of Nashville has earmarked \$5000.00 for participation in the economic development of the County.

WHEREAS, the County has by ordinance established. the Brown County Economic Development Commission and designated the office of the Auditor of Brown County as the proper depository of funds to be applied to the operation of said Commission.

IT IS THEREFORE, AGREED by and between the Nashville Town Council and the Brown County Board of Commissioners as follows:

- 1. The Town of Nashville shall pay the sum of \$5000.00 to Brown County through the office of the Auditor of Brown County for partial payment of expenses of the Brown County Economic Development Commission for the year 2009.
- 2. The Brown County Auditor shall have the duty to receive, disburse, and account for all monies of this joint undertaking.
- 3. Brown County shall use said payment to partially defer the expenses of the Brown County Economic Development Commission.
- 4. In the event that Brown County does not use all of said payment, any remaining unused portion of it shall be refunded to the Town of Nashville no later than 30 days after the close of the County's fiscal year for the year of 2009.
