ORDINANCE 2009-04 AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A RAINY DAY FUND

WHEREAS, the Town of Nashville has received excess CEDIT and excess CAGIT distribution funds from the Treasurer of Brown County and;

WHEREAS, the Town of Nashville must create a Rainy Day Fund to deposit excess CEDIT and excess CAGIT distribution funds and;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Town of Nashville, Brown County, Indiana that the Rainy Day Fund be established as follows:

SECTION 1. Establishment of the Rainy Day Fund

- (a) There is hereby created a "Rainy Day Fund". The fund shall consists of deposits in the form of unused and unencumbered funds under Indiana Code section five in chapter 36, IC 6-3.5-1.1-21; IC 6-3.5-6-17.3; or IC6-3.5-7-17.3 or any other funding sources not otherwise prohibited by law.
- (b) The Rainy Day Fund is subject to the same appropriation process as other funds that receive tax money
- (c) In any fiscal year, a political subdivision may transfer under Section five of Chapter 36, not more than then percent (10%) of the political subdivision's total annual budget for that fiscal year, adopted under IC 6-1.1-17, to the Rainy Day Fund.
- (d) The department of local government finance may not reduce the actual or maximum permissible levy of a political subdivision as a result of a balance in the Rainy Day Fund of a political subdivision.
- (e) The fund may be used for all purposes permitted by law.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon passage.
