ORDINANCE 2009-07

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NUMBER 2003-03 THE "HORSE-DRAWN CARRIAGE ORDINANCE"

WHEREAS, the Town Council has been asked to consider the licensing of vehicles similar to horsedrawn carriages and to increase the number of licenses permitted under the ordinance, it is, therefore, ordained as follows:

- 1. The ordinance to be amended appears in Chapter 115 of the Town of Nashville's Code of Ordinances.
 - 2. Section 115.01 be, and is, hereby amended to read as follows:

The operation of any horse-drawn vehicle upon the streets of the town for the purpose of transporting persons for hire or as a contractual service is a violation of this chapter unless operated in accordance with valid licenses issued pursuant to this chapter. The Clerk-Treasurer of the town is hereby authorized to issue up to a maximum of three (3) licenses concurrently pursuant to this chapter for the operation of horse-drawn carriage businesses. Application shall be made and fees paid for same no later than three (3) business days before the first day of commencing business in any calendar year. Licenses are annually renewable. However, should a license holder from the previous year not apply by April 1 of the application year, that license shall become available to other applicants.

3. The following additional section shall be inserted between Section 115.01 and Section 115.02:

DEFINITIONS

- (A) "Horse" shall include all draft animals used to draw vehicles such as, but not limited to: horses, mules, oxen, camels, burros, water buffalo, and reindeer.
- (B) "Carriage" shall include all vehicles drawn by animal power such as, but not limited to: wagons, carriages, surreys, buckboards, tumbrels, carts, sulkeys and sleighs.
- 4. All portions of any ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed and of no further force and effect.
- 5. If any section, subsection or clause of this ordinance shall be deemed to be invalid, the validity of the remaining provisions shall not be affected.

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect on the date of its passage.
