ORDINANCE 20 01 - 12

AN ORDINANCE TERMINATING COMPENSATION FOR RESERVE POLICE OFFICER MILEAGE CLAIMS

WHEREAS, it has come to the attention of the Town Council that the police reserve ordinance, section 33.02 provides for reimbursement to reserve police officer for mileage driving to and from their residences to the Town Hall, and;

WHEREAS, other workers are not entitled to reimbursement for mileage to and from their residence to their place of employment, nor is the expense of commuting to and from one's place of employment ordinarily a deductible expense under the IRS code, and; WHEREAS, that the State statute authorizing reserve police officers (IC 36-8-3-10) does not permit compensation for mileage between the officer's residence and his place of employment WHEREFORE, it is ordained as follows:

- 1. That Section 33.02 of the (A) (3) is hereby **amended** to read as follows:

 Reserve Police Officers are not paid employees.
- 2. The words,

"Reserve Police Officers shall be reimbursed for mileage to and from their residence to the Town Hall when scheduled to work by the Town Marshall."

Are hereby **deleted** from section 33.02 (A) (3).

- 3. **Repealer**. All provisions of the Code of Ordinances in conflict with the amendment made herein are hereby repealed.
 - 4. **Effective date**. This ordinance shall become effective upon passage.
