

**ORDINANCE NO. 2011-03A**

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NUMBER 2010-8A**

**WHEREAS**, The Town of Nashville, Indiana has passed Ordinance No. 2010-8A, which created the Department of Redevelopment, and the Town is now taking steps to implement said Ordinance by appointing Redevelopment Commissioners pursuant to said ordinance, and;

**WHEREAS**, Said Ordinance requires that each Commissioner have a bond as required by law, and that said Ordinance further provides that, the cost of the bond shall be paid by the special taxing district, and;

**WHEREAS**, The special taxing district does not yet exist nor have a budget item for payment of expenses such as the Commissioners bonds, which costs can be readily payable out of the Town general budget;

**THEREFORE**, the last sentence of Section 3(c) is unnecessary and should be stricken and deleted from the text of Ordinance 2010-8;

**BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF NASHVILLE, INDIANA**, that Ordinance 2010-8A be AMENDED as follows; the last sentence of Section 3(c), reading the cost of the bond shall be paid by the special taxing district is hereby DELETED. In all other regards Ordinance 2010-8A shall remain unchanged and in full force and effect.
