

**ORDINANCE NO. 2012- 05**  
**OF THE TOWN OF NASHVILLE, INDIANA**

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND BUSINESS LICENSE RULES AND PROCEDURES**

**WHEREAS:** The Town Business License Rules and Procedure were recently amended by Ordinance 2012-01; and

**WHEREAS:** In the practical application of said rules the requirement of a license for "display" is impractical and cumbersome to administer and is therefore hereby Ordained as follows: Ordinance No. 2012-2012-01 be hereby amended by the deletion from the first numbered paragraph of the second word in the second line and thereof "display".

The first numbered paragraph of Ordinance No. 2012-01 shall hence forth read as follows:

1. License required: No person, corporation, or other legal entities shall engage in the selling, display for sale of goods, wares, merchandise, food, beverages, or the advertising thereof at retail or whole sale, or provide entertainment or exhibition for a fee or admission charge without first obtaining a license. No person, corporation or other legal entities shall provide services within the Town of Nashville without first obtaining a license, unless the services are professional services, licensed and regulated by Indiana or the United States of America.

In all other regards Ordinance 2012-01 shall remain unchanged.

This amendment shall become effective upon passage
