# AN ORDINANCE REEANACTING TOWN ORDINANCE 2011-09 "LEGISLATIVE DISTRICTS"

**WHEREAS:** Ordinance 2010-02 and Ordinance 2010-03 were passed and ordained as a result of the annexation into the town of the Orchard Hill and Coffey Hill subdivisions; and

**WHEREAS:** Said redistricting took in the population data obtained from the 2010 United States Census; and

**WHEREAS:** The Census data did not change the precinct lines established by the County Clerk in the affected areas; and

**WHEREAS:** IC 36–5-2-4.1 mandates that Town Legislative Districts shall be determined "during the second year after a year in which a federal decennial census is conducted"

The Town Council ordained as follows: That Ordinance No. 2011-09 "Legislative Districts" (exhibit A attached hereto) is hereby reenacted in its entirety and shall henceforth be known as Ordinance 2012-

This Ordinance shall become effective upon passage.

# AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING TOWN COUNCIL REPRESENTATIVE DISTRICTS

Whereas, the Town of Nashville has annexed two large residential areas, that is "Coffey Hill" and "Orchard Hill" and;

Whereas, the 2010 Census has furnished current accurate population data and;

Whereas, the Town Council representative districts are required by law to be roughly equal in population.

IT IS THEREFORE incumbent upon the Council to amend the Town Council Representative District boundaries by ordinance in order to assure equality of representation for each district.


#### IT IS THEREFORE ORDAINED AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. That the boundaries of the Town's three legislative districts (District 1, District 2 and District 3) be and are hereby redefined according to the map which is attached hereto and incorporated as part of this ordinance as Exhibit A.
- 2. That paragraph's A (1) (2) and (3) of section 30.01 of the Town of Nashville Code of Ordinances are hereby repealed.
- 3. That this Ordinance shall become effective upon passage and a copy shall be filed by the Clerk-Treasurer with the Clerk of the Brown Circuit Court.
