ORDINANCE 2012-20

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 2011-10 FIXING SALARIES AND WAGES OF TOWN OFFICIALS AND EMPLOYEES OF THE TOWN OF NASHVILLE DURING THE YEAR 2012

WHEREAS, Indiana statute provides that the Town legislative body shall fix the salaries, benefits and compensation of its officers and employees.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Town of Nashville, Brown County, Indiana that, salaries, wages and other compensation of officials and employees for the year of 2012 shall be amended to include the following:

Office of the Town Administration

Additionally, during extraordinary circumstances determined as an emergency by the Town Administration, an employee may be asked to be on-call during the employee's vacation time off. If such circumstance is determined, the employee is expected to stay in the vicinity during the vacation period to receive the on-call pay. Town Administration will document the extraordinary circumstance to the office of the Clerk-Treasurer during the appropriate payroll cycle.

Crew Leader (1) \$10.75 to \$16.15 hourly Utility Maintenance Supervisor \$10.75 to \$16.15 hourly

Effective Date

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect retroactive from January 1, 2012 and after and shall be used in conjunction with the Town of Nashville's general personnel policies.
