

AN ORDINANCE REGARDING TRAILER PARKING REGULATION IN THE TOWN OF NASHVILLE IN THE STATE OF INDIANA

WHEREAS: The Town Council has become aware of an abuse of public parking space for the parking of trailers and non-powered wheeled vehicles;

No vehicle defined as a “trailer” under the Indiana Motor Vehicle Code (I.C. 9-13-2-184) shall be parked on a public street for a period exceeding four (4) hours within any twenty-four (24) hour period. Permits may be granted for special events or special circumstances allowing trailer parking in excess of the times set out herein.
