

ORDINANCE 2014-03

**AN ORDINANCE TO INCREASE THE FINE
FOR CERTAIN PARKING VIOLATIONS**

WHEREAS: During the busy months of the year parking remains at a premium in the Town and;


WHEREAS: Fines for parking violations have not been changed for almost ten (10) years and the costs of administration and enforcement has increased substantially.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDAINED THAT SECTION 71.99 OF THE TOWN OF NASHVILLE CODE OF ORDINANCES SHALL BE AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS:

A fine of \$25.00 shall be established for a violation of any parking regulation as established by the Town with the following exceptions: the fine for violation of parking in a handicap zone without a handicap permit or license plate shall be \$40.00 and the fine for parking in a designated no parking zone containing a fire hydrant shall be \$40.00.


This ordinance shall become effective upon passage and publication as required by law. All portions of Section 71.99 that are in conflict herewith are hereby REPEALED.


