

ORDINANCE 2014-04

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE TOWN PERSONNEL POLICY
TO REQUIRE DRIVING RECORD CHECKS FOR CERTAIN EMPLOYEES

WHEREAS: The Town Council, together with the advice of the Town Manager, believes that it would be reasonable and prudent to monitor the driving infraction records of those employees who operate Town vehicles and;

WHEREAS: The current personal policy does not include a mechanism by which motor vehicle infraction records of employees may be reviewed.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDAINED THAT SECTION 36.053 OF THE TOWN OF NASHVILLE CODE OF ORDINANCES – PERSONNEL POLICY BE AMENDED TO INCLUDE THE FOLLOWING SUB-SECTION:

(C) All Town employees who operate vehicles owned or leased by the Town shall be subject to a review of their Indiana Bureau of Motor Vehicles driver's records by their department head and the Town Manager. Said reviews shall be conducted at the discretion of the department heads and/or Town Manager at intervals no less frequent than annual.

This Ordinance shall become effective upon passage.


