

ORDINANCE 2014 – 6

AN ORDINANCE TO EXTEND ONE WAY TRAFFIC RESTRICTION
ON LOCUST LANE

WHEREAS; The Town Council has heretofore restricted traffic on Locust Lane to northbound traffic only from Main Street to Gould Street, and;


WHEREAS; With the construction of new Brown County History Center traffic on Locust Lane between Gould Street and Mound Street has become congested.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDAINED THAT CHAPTER 72 OF THE TOWN OF NASHVILLE CODE OF ORDINANCES, SCHEDULE 1, ONE WAY STREETS, BE AND IS AMENDED AS FOLLOWS:


Traffic on Locust Lane shall be restricted to northbound only, from Main Street to Mound Street.

This Ordinance shall become effective upon passage and publication as required by law. Town Administration is further directed to erect appropriate signage.

IT IS SO ORDAINED ON THIS 16th day of OCTOBER, 2014 BY THE AUTHORITY OF THE NASHVILLE TOWN COUNCIL.






