## ORDINANCE NO. 2020-13 TOWN OF NASHVILLE INDIANA

## AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 2020-04 AUTHORIZING ADDITIONAL EMERGENCY AUTHORITY OF THE PRESIDENT OF THE TOWN COUNCIL

**WHEREAS,** the President of the Town Council is the Town Executive and as such is vested by Statute (I.C. 10-14-3-29) with certain authority to act in emergency situations involving public safety, health and welfare and the best interest of the Town; and

**WHEREAS,** the Town Council of the Town of Nashville Indiana passed **ORDINANCE NO. 2020-04** on the 19<sup>th</sup> day of March, 2020 in response to the emerging pandemic of COVID-19. Said ordinance specified the emergency powers of the Town Executive; and

**WHEREAS**, the pandemic conditions in the Town have increased and the emergency still exists.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Town Council of the Town of Nashville, Indiana as follows:

- 1. Section 1 of Ordinance 2020-04 be amended to include the following emergency power of the Town Executive;
  - (d) Take all additional reasonable actions to carry out the orders and recommendations of the Governor, the Indiana State Department of Health and the Brown County Department of Public Health and Brown County Emergency Management issued to control the spread of COVID-19.
- 2. All other provisions of **ORDINANCE NO. 2020-04** shall remain in full force and effect.

This ordinance shall become effective upon passage.
