

TOWN OF NASHVILLE INDIANA ORDINANCE NUMBER 2021-13

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE 2009-14 TO
INCREASE SEWER CONNECTION FEES**

WHEREAS, the Town of Nashville's Utility Service Board has reviewed the costs associated with connecting new users to the Town's Wastewater Disposal system, and;

WHEREAS, the review indicates that there has been a substantial increase in the material, labor and administrative costs associated with new connections to the wastewater system since the enactment of Ordinance 2009-14, and;

WHEREAS, a reasonable increase of the connection fees is necessary to prevent a loss to the Wastewater Utility on new connections, and;

WHEREAS, the Town Council has complied with the Notice and Hearing requirements of I.C. 36-9-23-26.

It is therefore **ORDAINED** that Section 3, subsection c) "Connection Fees" of Town of Nashville Indiana Ordinance 2009-14 be amended as follows:

Connection Fees

1. All new wastewater connections shall be subject to an administrative and review fee of \$100
2. **Gravity Connection:** Gravity sewer connection within twenty (20) feet of an existing gravity sewer: Four-inch (4") sewer tap, for single-family residences and small businesses serviced by a 5/8" water meter, basic charge, **Two Thousand Two Hundred Dollars (\$2,200.00)**. Where a gravity connection requires work and or materials above the work and material contemplated above, there shall be an additional charge for the actual costs of labor, material, power, machinery, transportation and overhead for installing the connection.
3. **Pressure Connection:** Pressure sewer connection within twenty (20) feet of an existing sewer main: *Simplex* or equivalent pumping station for single-family residences and small businesses serviced by a 5/8" water meter, basic charge, **Six Thousand Six Hundred Dollars (\$6,600.00)** Where a pressure connection requires work and or materials above the work and material contemplated above, there shall be an additional charge for the actual costs of labor, material, power, machinery, transportation and overhead for installing the connection.

ORDINANCE 2021-13

REPEALER: All terms and provisions of Town of Nashville Indiana Ordinance Number 2009-14 in conflict with this amendment are hereby **REPEALED**. All other terms and provisions of said ordinance shall remain unchanged.

SEVERABILITY: If any terms or provisions of this amendment are found to be unconstitutional, illegal or unenforceable, it shall not affect the enforceability of the remaining terms.

EFFECTIVE DATE: This Ordinance shall become effective upon passage.
