## **ORDINANCE NO. 2022-02**

## AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 90 OF THE NASHVILLE CODE OF ORDINANCES

WHEREAS, the Nashville Town Council has determined that Brown County has placed a dog tax on dogs that are owned by persons living in the Town of Nashville.

**WHEREAS**, it has been determined by the Council that the dog licensing requirement by the Town of Nashville is therefore unnecessary;

## IT IS THEREFORE ORDAINED AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. Section 90.01 LICENSE REQUIRED, Section 90.02 LICENSE APPLICATIONS, Section 90.03 CLERK-TREASURER TO ISSUE LICENSE, Section 90.04 FEES shall be stricken from the Nashville Ordinances, and shall be replaced with the following:
- 2. 90.01 INSURANCE OR FINANCIAL RESPONSIBILITY FOR DOG. In the event that a dog whose owner lives in Nashville, Indiana, causes damage to a person or property who files a complaint with the Nashville Police Department, Brown County Sheriff's Department or Brown County Animal Control, the person owning the dog shall be required to provide proof of insurance or financial responsibility for the dog to Brown County Animal Control. In the event that proof is not provided, the dog may be deemed a nuisance by the Brown County Humane Society.
- 3. Section 90.05 CONFINEMENT OF FEMALE DOGS IN HEAT, DANGEROUS DOGS, SICK OR DISEASED DOGS shall replace the term County Humane Society with the term "Brown County Humane Society", also known as "BCHS" throughout Section 90.05.
- 4. **Section 90.07 NUISANCE** shall be stricken from the Nashville Ordinances and shall be replaced with the following: Any dog whose owner lives in Nashville, Indiana, which creates a disturbance as described in Section 90.06 is hereby declared to be a nuisance.
- 5. **Section 90.08 IMPOUNDMENT** shall replace the term County Humane Society with the name, "Brown County Humane Society", also known as BCHS.
- 6. The Town will dissolve their Dog License Fund and the remaining balance shall be given to the Brown County Humane Society.
