## RESOLUTION No: 2006-3 AUTHORIZING APPLICATION OF GRANT MODIFICATION

Resolution of the Town Council of the Town of Nashville, Indiana, Authorizing the Submittal of the Application of Grant Modification to the Indiana Office of Community and Rural Affairs

WHEREAS, the Town Council of Nashville, Indiana recognizes the need to stimulate growth and to maintain a sound economy within its corporate limits; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Nashville Indiana, has been awarded a CDBG Community Focus Fund (CFF) grant to assist in the Downtown Revitalization having a project identification number of CF-04-226 and,

WHEREAS, the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, as amended, authorizes the Indiana Office of Community and Rural Affairs to provide grants to local units of government to meet the housing and community development needs of low and moderate income persons; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Nashville, Indiana, has conducted, or will conduct, prior to submission of a major modification request to the Indiana Office of Rural Affairs, a public hearing to discuss performance on the grant as awarded as well as the reasons for requesting said major modification to the grant which will increase the amount of CDBG grant funding from \$450,000 to \$500,000; this public hearing will be held to invite comments from interested citizens on the proposed modification request.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Town Council of Nashville, Indiana that:

- 1. The Town Council President is authorized to prepare and submit an application for grant modification to address unforeseen improvements to their Downtown Revitalization Project and to execute and administer a resultant grant including requisite general administration and project management, contract and agreements pursuant to regulations of the Indiana Office of Community and Rural Affairs and the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development.
- 2. The Town of Nashville, Indiana hereby commits to the removal of two unknown fuel tanks and the replacement of an old inadequate unstable storm drain that was a very old 4' arch structure unable serve its original function and support the weight of the road.
